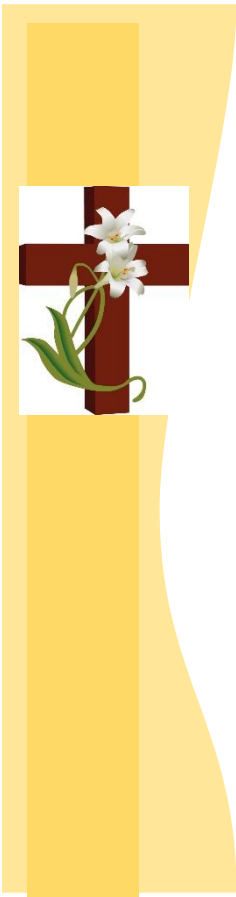

Pop Up Youth Event: Focus on Gratitude

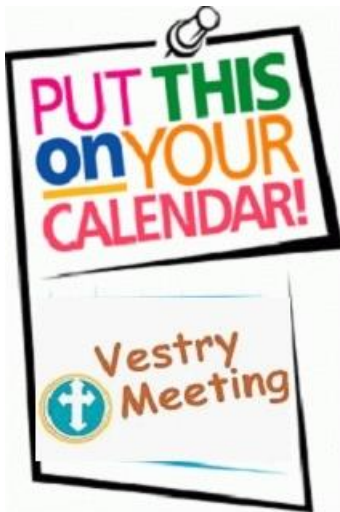
Sun, Nov 17 2019, 3:30pm to 6:30pm

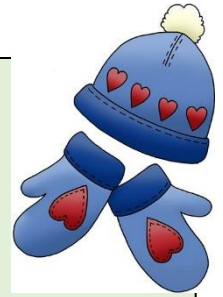
Teresa is also looking for a couple of adult volunteers to help hang some smoke alarms in the church. Please contact her if you can help out.

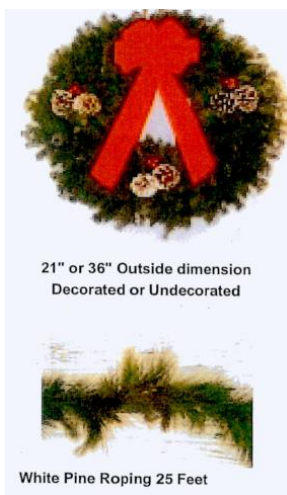
